PPHSS CATTLE EXTRAVAGANZA – April 10 – 11, 2010

Entry Fees Per Horse – “Horse may crossover to other divisions for no additional fee”
NO FREE crossover in Working Ranch Horse Competition, you pay for all classes entered.

NEW FEES..... \$80.00 + cattle charge if applicable – 5 or more performance classes, any combination of divisions **not including Ranch Sorting or Working Ranch Horse Competition.**

\$50.00 / HALTER Class – \$80.00 / Multiple HALTER Classes (any combination)

\$125 / Youth All Day Fee (includes cattle charges)

\$260 / Cattle Classes + Performance Classes - All Day Fee (5 or more Cattle & Performance CLASSES in a single division **not including Ranch Sorting or Working Ranch Horse Competition**) - Open, Novice Amateur, Amateur (includes cattle charges except cutting)

\$30.00 / Class + cattle charges if applicable – Individual performance classes up to 5 classes

CATTLE CHARGES: SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Cutting: \$60.00 per run

Roping: \$25.00 per run

Working Cowhorse: \$30.00 per run

RANCH SORTING ONLY (**not included in all day fee**) - \$20.00 per team + \$20.00 Cattle Charge

WORKING RANCH HORSE COMPETITION ONLY (**not included in all day fee**) Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur and Youth - \$20.00 per class + \$20.00 cattle charge if applicable = \$100.00 (all 4 classes per division)

TSCC Fees: \$1.00/class

RV: \$25.00/day

STALL/GROUND FEE: \$25.00/day.....

Shavings: Prevailing rate posted at show / bag (1 bag minimum) NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS

Reining and Working Ranch Horse Clinic – after Sat. Show.....not before 2:00 pm to allow more time for clinic
\$60.00 – Clinic Must sign up for clinic at secretaries desk.

HIGH POINT DIVISIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS Youth, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Junior Horse and Senior Horse **MUST** show in respective halter class plus three performance classes per division.

HIGH POINT STOCK HORSE must show in all 4 stock horse classes per division.

CATTLE AND STALL RESERVATIONS; RESERVE NO LATER THAN April 1, 2010. CATTLE FEE PENALTY: A penalty of 1/2 original charges will be applied if cattle is not reserved by April 1, 2010.
